

FUN MEET INFORMATION

Purpose: This meet is primarily to introduce new swimmers to swim meets in a low key way. There will be no points kept, and heats will be arranged so that as far as possible swimmers will be in a heat that matches their abilities.

Sunday, May 30th, 2010 Salmon Arm pool

Brief Warm-up, 9-9:20 a.m. Meet starts 9:20 a.m. Meets end at Noon.

In other words we only have the pool for 3 hours.

We will stop the meet wherever we are at when time is up.

All swimmers:

Must be registered to compete.

Cost is \$10 per swimmer.

Turtles are no cost.

Assisted Turtles: Swimmers any age who will need floatation device or a person to help them.

Unassisted Turtles, Generally 6 and under. 7 and older can also compete if 1 length of a stroke is their maximum ability. However if a 7 and older can do a 50 they should participate in the novice or proper age group event. See the meet manager –Carl for any ‘exceptional circumstances’. You can also email me in advance (coop@sunlite.ca) so we can make arrangements for any unusual situation.

Novice events are all for first year swimmers (last year turtles can swim Novice).

** A swimmer may swim in different categories, but not in the same stroke/event. e.g. assisted turtles for fly, but Novice 8 and under for Free.

Disqualifications We are trying to encourage all swimmers to swim, therefore there are no disqualifications for Div. 3 and under (unless a swimmer is purposely trying to gain an unfair advantage).

Ribbons. –All swimmers will receive a ribbon

Open events: There will be an open 400 Free at the end of the day (time allowing).

200 Free: Is an open event you can move a swimmer up (from Div. 1, 2 or 3) to swim in the Div. 4 200 Free if you would like. However PLEASE WRITE THE EVENT NUMBER IN BESIDE THEIR NAME ON THE EXCEL SPREAD SHEET (101 OR 102)

Mystery I.M.’s. For Division 3 and up, the 100 I.M. ‘order of strokes’ will be a mystery’, the order will be drawn out of a hat in the marshalling area for each ‘group’.

A hosted barbecue (cost to be announced later) immediately following completion of the swim meet. Around about \$3 for a burger and drink. This has always been a fun, get together time!!!

Seating: Bring lawn chairs. Due to the size of the meet (small) we will not be putting up bleachers. Bring your own seat. Good news...there should be lots of room. Also we provide seats for timers.....and we need lots of timers.
