

Revelstoke Aquaducks Swim Club --2011 Invitational Meet July 16 and 17, 2011



Location: Revelstoke Aquatic Centre, 600 Campbell Ave.

Facilities: **Revelstoke Aquatic Centre** is an indoor 25 meter pool with 6 lanes. Spectator seating is limited. We are pleased to offer our large indoor, air-conditioned multi purpose room to keep cool between your races.

Onsite Camping: Is available at the Centennial Ball Fields alongside the Columbia River. Camping fee is \$15 per night. This is located directly west about one block from the pool. The 6th St. parking lot adjacent to the pool may be available for self-contained units.

Club Tents: Are allowed outside the pool, between the road and the river, however most swimmers hang out inside the multi-purpose room

Concession: Will be available for early risers and through the day. Lunches can be purchased daily.

- * Saturday warm ups: 7:00 am Div 1-4 and 7:20 am Div 5-8
- * Sunday warm ups: 7:00 am Div 5-8 and 7:20 am Div 1-4
- * Officials Meeting: 7:30 am each morning
- * Coaches Meeting: 7:45 am each morning
- * Meet Start time: 8:00 am each morning

Lunch break: For 45 minutes after the completion of morning heats. Followed by warmups for the next 30 minutes. Finals to follow.

Entries: **DEADLINE: TUESDAY, JULY 12, 2011 @ 8:00 PM**

Entry Fees: A flat fee of \$30 per swimmer will be charged, excluding turtles (FREE). A surcharge of \$1.00 per swimmer, **including** turtles will be added to meet fees for the Regional Timing Improvement Fee (TIF). There will be no refunds for scratched swimmers. Payment is expected in full to the meet manager (Scott LeBuke) during the Sunday lunch break

Turtles: All turtles must be registered with their home club and be registered for the meet using Hy-tek. Ribbons and goodie bags will be presented to all.

Relays: Relay entries must be submitted on proper entry forms to the clerk of course prior to 10AM each day.

Scratches: By 8:00 pm Friday at the pool for Saturday events. Following the finals on Saturday for the Sunday events.

Rules:

- * All BCSSA rules apply or as the Meet Manager deems fit and fair.
- * Hytek Meet Manager software will be used to 'crash' times.
- * All individual events, except Div 8 will be heats and finals.
- * Relays and Div 8 will be timed finals.
- * Div 8 will swim in the morning and Relays are at the end of the day.
- * Swimmers may enter any 4 individual events plus relays.
- * Division 1-4 will swim both finals and consolation finals, if there are more than 8 swimmers in the heats.
- * Division 5-8 swim only finals (no consolations)
- * "O" swimmers may swim in the finals or consolations of their event provided a lane is available. "O" swimmers will not displace an "S" swimmer in either a final or consolation.

* Division 5-8 and all relays: ribbons will be awarded to top 6 swimmers.
* Aggregate medals will be awarded for girls and boys in each division.
* Team awards will be Top Girls team, Top Boys team and Top Overall Team.
